

## Message Outline

### **Luke 6:12-19 (NIV)**

...Jesus went out to a mountainside to pray, and spent the night praying to God. <sup>13</sup> When morning came, he called his disciples to him and chose twelve of them, whom he also designated apostles...

<sup>7</sup> He went down with them and stood on a level place. A large crowd of his disciples was there and a great number of people from all over Judea, from Jerusalem, and from the coastal region around Tyre and Sidon, <sup>18</sup> who had come to hear him and to be healed of their diseases. Those troubled by impure spirits were cured, <sup>19</sup> and the people all tried to touch him, because power was coming from him and healing them all.

## Life Group Discussion Guide

1. Pastor Billy discussed living under the influence of the old kingdom instead of fully embracing God's kingdom, the new kingdom of our lives. Have you ever struggled with falling into your old life before Christ instead of living in the kingdom you've been saved into?
2. Jesus brought revolutionary change through his teachings and miracles. Some people jumped in and accepted this change and others turned away. Is there change in your life right now? How do you handle change? How can you be sure you're trusting in God during times of transition?
3. Pastor Billy shared the story of the prostitute crashing the party in Luke 7:44-50. Please read these verses with your group. Think about this scenario in modern times. Who might you be judging or rejecting that Jesus is wholeheartedly loving and forgiving? How can you show love to people that get overlooked?
4. Read and discuss Romans 13:12-14 and Colossians 3:1-3. Are there things you need to start doing to help you "Set your mind on things above, not on things on the earth" and to "live decent lives for all to see"? What does that look like for you in daily life? What practices could you incorporate to help you?
5. Pastor Billy discussed how the prostitute crashed the party to see Jesus. Read the story of the pearl of great price in Matthew 13:45-46. How do these two stories compare to each other? What can we learn from them?
